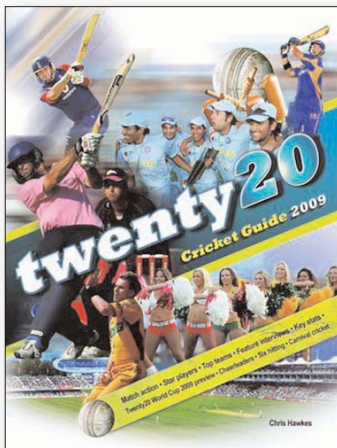


Treasures of the Tour De France

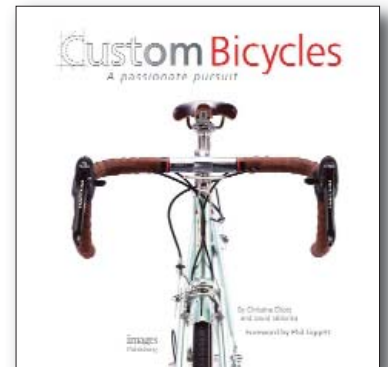

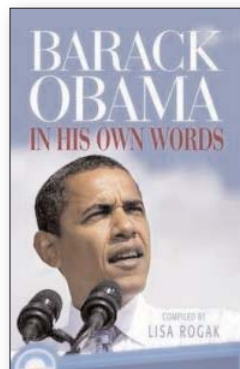


Twenty20 Cricket Guide 2009

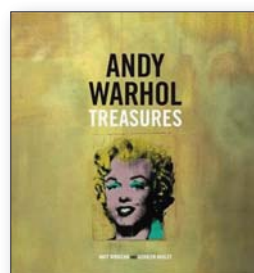


Barack Obama: In His Own Words

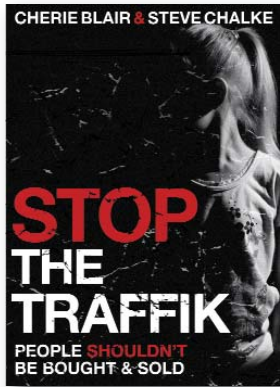


Treasures of Andy Warhol

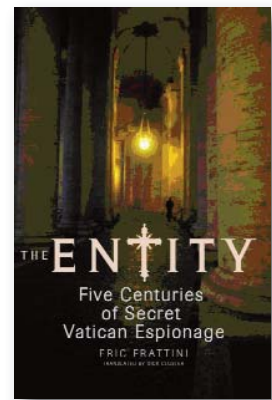


Stop the Traffik

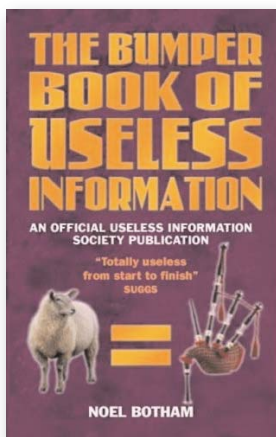

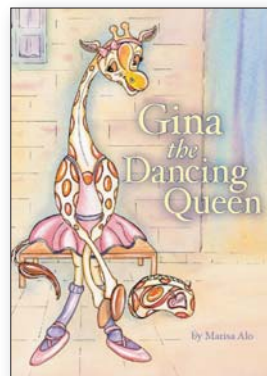

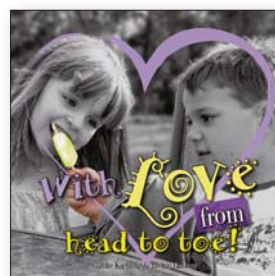


Gina the Dancing Queen
